2010 news about SPGNA members:

Prof. Satish Singh – received "AGU Fellow award"

Prof. Satish Singh was born in Varanasi, India and completed his education at Banaras Hindu University and University of Toronto, Canada, and is currently a Professor in Paris, France. He has published over 110 papers in peer-reviewed journals, including nine in Nature and Science. He has supervised over 50 Ph.D. students and post-doctoral researchers. He was awarded AGU Fellow in 2010 for his exceptional contributions to Earth and space sciences.



Dr. Jyoti Behura - received "SEG best Geophysics paper award"

Jyoti completed his PhD in May 2009 from Colorado School of Mines and is currently a geophysicist with BP Houston. Jyoti Behura and professor Ilya Tsvankin received SEG's Best Paper in Geophysics Award at the SEG's Annual Meeting in Denver for their paper "Role of the inhomogeneity angle in anisotropic attenuation analysis." This work provides a basis for using directionally-dependent attenuation coefficients in fracture characterization & lithology discrimination.



Dip Shankar Nanda – geoscience journey from India to USA

Dip's first experience with Geophysics was in the form of Geography in school. He then joined 5 years integrated course in Applied Geology at IIT Kharagpur. After Kharagpur he got admission in the University of Houston (UH), from where he completed MS degree in 2010. The title of his MS thesis work was: Spectral Decomposition of Seismic Data using Mu-Pseudo-Wavelets and Mu-Wavelets. Since August 2010 he has been working full time with Geokinetics.
